Empowerment & Capacity Building of Women through SHGs

Women empowerment is pivotal for the development of any community. The role of Self-Help Groups (SHG) in this regard is seen as vital. SHG becomes an effective platform for collective action by women in the rural scope. It helps them come out of isolation and presents an array of opportunities in terms of savings and taking up self and collective employment. Hence, SHGs facilitate the overall socio-economic development of women.

SHGs for Livelihood plays an important role in Bihar's change. Today, more than one crore Didis (Beneficiaries) are constantly improving their life by connecting with SHGs. SHGs are moving beyond their capacity to build financial inclusion, build community institutions, and connect with related activities. A large number of SHGs have been added to livelihood related activities from agriculture, non-agriculture, animal husbandry etc., as a result of which these Didis are becoming financially empowered. The capacity building of Self-Help Group members through vigorous training plays an essential role in empowering women and the future sustainability of SHGs.
