

| 2. | Formulation of Scheme | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As mandated by the Section 38 of the Act, the draft Scheme have been prepared. • Principal Secretary instructed to circulate the draft Scheme among the TVCs that have been formed (15 Nos.) and other ULBs (As the Commissioners and Executive Officers are the President of the TVC) for their comments. • Letter from to all ULBs to be written with instructions from the Principal Secretary to review the Scheme and forward their comments to Ms. Indu Kumari. In case the comments were not received within the time frame, it should be construed that the TVC / ULB does not have any comment with regard to the Scheme. • A state level stakeholder consultation workshop to be organised to finalise the Scheme. |

DMs to be requested to ensure that the meeting of the TVC takes place to take decisions as per per the requirement of the Act. |
| 4. | Implementation of the Act by the district administration and ULBs | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All District Magistrates, Senior Superintendent of Police and Municipal Authorities to be instructed by the Chief Secretary to implement various provisions, specially Section 3.3 and 27 of the Street Vendor's Act 2014. Department to draft the letter and place on the file to the office of Chief Secretary for approval. |
| 5. | Survey of Street Vendors in all the ULBs | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In the first phase, department with the support from NASVI has already started the survey, both form-based and biometric in the NULM towns i.e. 42 towns. Since the Act applies to all the Local Bodies, rest of the Local Bodies other than covered under NULM should be instructed to initiate the Survey work in their respective towns.• ULBs may consult the representatives of the NASVI for understanding the formats and process of identification and registration of Street Vendors.• PMC-NULM has been instructed to organise training programme for all the ULBs (142) through video conference to facilitate the survey work in all the ULBs. |
